Champoeg Park - Newberg, OR

Next time you're in Oregon, go check out the Nature Play Area at Champoeg Park. Designed by Learning Landscapes Design, Champoeg Park integrates natural elements like Cadron Creek's stainless steel Pump-n-Play alongside wood-en logs. Jacobson Park Playground in Lexington boasts two Pump-n-Plays. Jacobson Park is a 216-acre park in Lexington, Kentucky. They recently opened the park which includes two Cadron Creek Pump-n-Play Playground Pump Systems.

Artificial riverbeds were created with a pump positioned in opposite directions. The children can dam up the water and then release it. Lexington Parks & Rec opted for an angled nozzle on the spout, which directs the water in the appropriate direction.

Pump-n-Play in Japan - Okinawa

The Pump-n-Play pulls the water from the reservoir seen to the left. The Stainless Steel tank fills with water and is manually pumped out. The spout is equipped with a hose bibb for a water hose connection, or you can hang a bucket on the pail hook!
